REPRESENTATION BY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY IN 8 CERTAIN OTHER [SUBSEQUENT] ACTIONS. 9 Subject to the Texas 10 Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct, a [A] prosecuting attorney [who represents a party in a proceeding under this 11 is not precluded from representing <u>a party in a</u> 12 subtitle] proceeding under this subtitle and the Department of Family and 13 Protective Services in <u>another</u> [a subsequent] action involving the 14 party, regardless of whether the proceeding under this subtitle 15 occurs before, concurrently with, or after the other action 16 17 involving the party. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 21 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
