- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 81.0075, Family Code, is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 Sec. 81.0075. REPRESENTATION BY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY IN
- 9 CERTAIN OTHER [SUBSEQUENT] ACTIONS. A prosecuting attorney [who
- 10 represents a party in a proceeding under this subtitle] is not
- 11 precluded from representing a party in a proceeding under this
- 12 <u>subtitle and</u> the Department of Family and Protective Services in
- 13 <u>another</u> [a subsequent] action involving the party, regardless of
- 14 whether the proceeding under this subtitle occurs before,
- 15 concurrently with, or after the other action involving the party.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
