	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to the amounts of administrative penalties assessed or
3	imposed against certain health facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 241.059(b) and (c), Health and Safety
6	Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(b) In determining the amount of the penalty, the
8	commissioner of health shall consider:
9	(1) the hospital's previous violations;
10	(2) the seriousness of the violation;
11	(3) any threat to the health, safety, or rights of the
12	hospital's patients;
13	(4) the demonstrated good faith of the hospital; [and]
14	(5) the effect of the penalty on the hospital's ability
15	to continue to provide services; and
16	(6) such other matters as justice may require.
17	(c) The penalty may not exceed <u>\$25,000</u> [ <del>\$1,000</del> ] for each
18	violation, except that the penalty for a violation of Section
19	166.004 shall be \$500. Each day of a continuing violation, other
20	than a violation of Section 166.004, may be considered a separate
21	violation.
22	SECTION 2. Section 243.015(c), Health and Safety Code, is
23	amended to read as follows:
24	(c) The amount of the penalty may not exceed <u>\$25,000</u>

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1 [\$1,000] for each violation, and each day a violation continues or 2 occurs is a separate violation for purposes of imposing a penalty. 3 [The total amount of the penalty assessed for a violation 4 continuing or occurring on separate days under this subsection may 5 not exceed \$5,000.]

6 SECTION 3. Section 251.066(b), Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:

8 (b) The penalty may not exceed <u>\$25,000</u> [<del>\$1,000</del>] for each 9 violation. Each day of a continuing violation constitutes a 10 separate violation.

SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 11 the assessment or imposition of an administrative penalty under 12 Section 241.059, 243.015, or 251.066, Health and Safety Code, for a 13 violation that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. 14 15 The assessment or imposition of an administrative penalty under Section 241.059, 243.015, or 251.066, Health and Safety Code, for a 16 17 violation that occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the violation occurred, 18 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 19

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
