## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the average price below which a newspaper is exempt from
- 3 the sales tax.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (f), Section 151.319, Tax Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (f) In this section, "newspaper" means a publication that is
- 8 printed on newsprint, the average sales price of which for each copy
- 9 over a 30-day period does not exceed  $\frac{$3}{$}$  [ $\frac{$1.50}{$}$ ], and that is printed
- 10 and distributed at a daily, weekly, or other short interval for the
- 11 dissemination of news of a general character and of a general
- 12 interest. "Newspaper" does not include a magazine, handbill,
- 13 circular, flyer, sales catalog, or similar printed item unless the
- 14 printed item is printed for distribution as a part of a newspaper
- 15 and is actually distributed as a part of a newspaper. For the
- 16 purposes of this section, an advertisement is news of a general
- 17 character and of a general interest. Notwithstanding any other
- 18 provision of this subsection, "newspaper" includes:
- 19 (1) a publication containing articles and essays of
- 20 general interest by various writers and advertisements that is
- 21 produced for the operator of a licensed and certified carrier of
- 22 persons and distributed by the operator to its customers during
- 23 their travel on the carrier; and
- 24 (2) a publication for the dissemination of news of a

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- 1 general character and of a general interest that is printed on
- 2 newsprint and distributed to the general public free of charge at a
- 3 daily, weekly, or other short interval.
- 4 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 5 affect taxes imposed before the effective date of this Act. Taxes
- 6 imposed before the effective date of this Act are governed by the
- 7 law in effect when the taxes were imposed, and that law is continued
- 8 in effect for purposes of the liability for and collection of those
- 9 taxes.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2013, if it
- 11 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 12 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 13 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- 14 date, this Act takes effect October 1, 2013.
