## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the issuance to veterans of specially marked licenses
- 3 to carry a concealed handgun and specially marked personal
- 4 identification certificates.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 411.174, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) The application must provide space for the applicant
- 9 <u>to:</u>

- 10 (1) list any military service that may qualify the
- 11 applicant to receive a license with a veteran's designation under
- 12 Section 411.179(e); and
- 13 (2) include proof required by the department to
- 14 determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 411.179, Government Code, is amended by
- 16 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 17 follows:
- 18 (a) The department by rule shall adopt the form of the
- 19 license. A license must include:
- 20 (1) a number assigned to the license holder by the
- 21 department;
- 22 (2) a statement of the period for which the license is
- 23 effective;
- 24 (3) a statement of the category or categories of

- 1 handguns the license holder may carry as provided by Subsection
- 2 (b);
- 4 (5) the license holder's full name, date of birth, hair
- 5 and eye color, height, weight, and signature;
- 6 (6) the license holder's residence address or, as
- 7 provided by Subsection (d), the street address of the courthouse in
- 8 which the license holder or license holder's spouse serves as a
- 9 federal judge or the license holder serves as a state judge; [and]
- 10 (7) the number of a driver's license or an
- 11 identification certificate issued to the license holder by the
- 12 department; and
- 13 (8) the designation "VETERAN" if required under
- 14 Subsection (e).
- 15 (e) In this subsection, "veteran" has the meaning assigned
- 16 by Section 411.1951. The department shall include the designation
- 17 "VETERAN" on the face of any original, duplicate, modified, or
- 18 renewed license under this subchapter or on the reverse side of the
- 19 license, as determined by the department, if the license is issued
- 20 to a veteran who:
- 21 (1) requests the designation; and
- 22 (2) provides proof sufficient to the department of the
- 23 <u>veteran's military service and honorable discharge.</u>
- SECTION 3. Section 521.101, Transportation Code, is amended
- 25 by adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 26 (1) The application for the personal identification
- 27 certificate must provide space for the applicant:

- 1 (1) to voluntarily list any military service that may
- 2 qualify the applicant to receive a personal identification
- 3 certificate with a veteran's designation under Section 521.102; and
- 4 (2) to include proof required by the department to
- 5 determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation.
- 6 SECTION 4. Subchapter E, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Section 521.102 to read as follows:
- 8 <u>Sec. 521.102. DESIGNATOR ON PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION</u>
- 9 CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO VETERAN. (a) In this section, "veteran"
- 10 means a person who:
- 11 (1) has served in:
- 12 (A) the army, navy, air force, coast guard, or
- 13 marine corps of the United States; or
- 14 (B) the Texas National Guard as defined by
- 15 Section 431.001, Government Code; and
- 16 (2) has been honorably discharged from the branch of
- 17 the service in which the person served.
- 18 (b) The department shall include the designation "VETERAN"
- 19 on a personal identification certificate issued to a veteran in an
- 20 available space on the face of the personal identification
- 21 certificate or on the reverse side of the personal identification
- 22 <u>certificate if:</u>
- 23 (1) the veteran requests the designation; and
- 24 (2) the veteran provides proof sufficient to the
- 25 department of the veteran's military service and honorable
- 26 discharge.
- 27 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
