6	SECTION 1. Section 411.174, Government Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
8	(b-1) The application must provide space for the applicant
9	<u>to:</u>
10	(1) list any military service that may qualify the
11	applicant to receive a license with a veteran's designation under
12	Section 411.179(e); and
13	(2) include proof required by the department to
14	determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation.
15	SECTION 2. Section 411.179, Government Code, is amended by
16	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
17	follows:
18	(a) The department by rule shall adopt the form of the
19	license. A license must include:
20	(1) a number assigned to the license holder by the
21	department;
22	(2) a statement of the period for which the license is
23	effective;
24	(3) a statement of the category or categories of

handguns the license holder may carry as provided by Subsection 1 2 (b); (4) a color photograph of the license holder; 3 the license holder's full name, date of birth, hair 4 (5) and eye color, height, weight, and signature; 5 6 (6) the license holder's residence address or, as 7 provided by Subsection (d), the street address of the courthouse in which the license holder or license holder's spouse serves as a 8 9 federal judge or the license holder serves as a state judge; [and] driver's 10 (7) the number of а license or an identification certificate issued to the license holder by the 11 12 department; and (8) the designation "VETERAN" 13 if required under 14 Subsection (e). (e) In this subsection, "veteran" has the meaning assigned 15 16 by Section 411.1951. The department shall include the designation 17 "VETERAN" on the face of any original, duplicate, modified, or 18 renewed license under this subchapter or on the reverse side of the license, as determined by the department, if the license is issued 19 20 to a veteran who: (1) requests the designation; and 21 22 (2) provides proof sufficient to the department of the veteran's military service and honorable discharge. 23 SECTION 3. Section 521.101, Transportation Code, is amended 24 25 by adding Subsection (1) to read as follows: (1) The application for the personal identification 26 27 certificate must provide space for the applicant:

1	(1) to voluntarily list any military service that may

6	SECTION 4. Subchapter E, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
7	is amended by adding Section 521.102 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 521.102. DESIGNATOR ON PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION
9	CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO VETERAN. (a) In this section, "veteran"
10	means a person who:
11	(1) has served in:
12	(A) the army, navy, air force, coast guard, or
13	marine corps of the United States; or
14	(B) the Texas National Guard as defined by
15	Section 431.001, Government Code; and
16	(2) has been honorably discharged from the branch of
17	the service in which the person served.
18	(b) The department shall include the designation "VETERAN"
19	on a personal identification certificate issued to a veteran in an
20	available space on the face of the personal identification
21	certificate or on the reverse side of the personal identification
22	certificate if:
23	(1) the veteran requests the designation; and
24	(2) the veteran provides proof sufficient to the
25	department of the veteran's military service and honorable
26	discharge.
27	SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
