5	SECTION 1. Section 542.059, Insurance Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
7	follows:
8	(b) <u>Claim-handling</u> [In the event of a weather-related
9	catastrophe or major natural disaster, as defined by the
10	commissioner, the claim-handling] deadlines imposed under this
11	subchapter are extended for an additional 15 days <u>on the date that:</u>
12	(1) the governor declares a state of natural disaster
13	under Section 418.014, Government Code; or
14	(2) if the governor does not declare a state of natural
15	disaster under Section 418.014, Government Code, the commissioner
16	declares a weather-related catastrophe under Subsection (c).
17	(c) The commissioner shall declare a weather-related
18	catastrophe if the commissioner determines that, for all insurers
19	writing insurance in an area designated by the commissioner and
20	defined by reasonable boundaries, as of the date of the declaration
21	a weather-related event resulted in, or may reasonably be expected
22	to result in:
23	(1) \$5 million or more in aggregate insured losses; or
24	(2) 3,000 or more claims.
