4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 31.0355(b), Human Resources Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(b) If a recipient of financial assistance who receives the
8	assistance by electronic benefits transfer to an account is
9	authorized to make a cash withdrawal from the account through a
10	provider of the goods or services described by Subsection (a), the
11	recipient may make the cash withdrawal only:
12	(1) at the customer service department of the provider
13	and not at the provider's point-of-sale terminal; and
14	(2) after the recipient presents the provider with
15	photo identification in accordance with Section 31.0356.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 31, Human Resources Code,
17	is amended by adding Section 31.0356 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 31.0356. PHOTO IDENTIFICATION FOR CERTAIN CASH
19	WITHDRAWALS. (a) In this section, "photo identification" means a
20	card or other document that:
21	(1) is issued by a governmental entity to identify an
22	individual; and
23	(2) displays a photograph of the individual identified
24	on the card or other document.

1 (b) A recipient of financial assistance who receives the 2 assistance by electronic benefits transfer to an account may not 3 make a cash withdrawal from the account through a provider of the 4 goods or services described by Section 31.0355(a) unless the 5 recipient presents photo identification verifying the recipient's 6 identity as the account holder.

7 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act 8 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 9 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 10 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 11 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 12 waiver or authorization is granted.

13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
