- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (g) To receive an exemption under Subsection (b) or (f), an
- 8 organization must annually:
- 9 $\underline{\text{(1)}}$ have an audit prepared by an independent auditor
- 10 that includes[. The audit must include] a detailed report on the
- 11 organization's sources and uses of funds; and
- 12 (2) deliver a[. A] copy of the audit [must be]
- 13 delivered] to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs
- 14 and to the chief appraiser of the appraisal district in which the
- 15 property subject to the exemption is located.
- SECTION 2. Subsections (b) and (c), Section 11.1826, Tax
- 17 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 18 (b) Property may not be exempted under Section 11.1825 for a
- 19 tax year unless the organization owning or controlling the owner of
- 20 the property:
- 21 <u>(1)</u> has an audit prepared by an independent auditor
- 22 covering the organization's most recent fiscal year that:
- 23 (A) is[. The audit must be] conducted in
- 24 accordance with generally accepted accounting principles; and

- 1 (B) includes[. The audit must include] an
- 2 opinion on whether:
- (i) $[\frac{(1)}{(1)}]$ the financial statements of the
- 4 organization present fairly, in all material respects and in
- 5 conformity with generally accepted accounting principles, the
- 6 financial position, changes in net assets, and cash flows of the
- 7 organization; and
- 8 $\underline{\text{(ii)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}$] the organization has complied
- 9 with all of the terms and conditions of the exemption under Section
- 10 11.1825; and
- 11 (2) delivers a copy of the audit in accordance with
- 12 <u>Subsection (c)</u>.
- 13 (c) Not later than the 180th day after the last day of the
- 14 organization's most recent fiscal year, the organization must
- 15 deliver a copy of the audit to the department and the chief
- 16 appraiser of the appraisal district in which the property is
- 17 located. The chief appraiser may extend the deadline for good cause
- 18 shown.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014.
