C.S.S.B. No. 201

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to the continuation and functions of the State
3 Preservation Board.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 443.002, Government Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 443.002. SUNSET PROVISION. The State Preservation
8 Board is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless
9 continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the board is
10 abolished and this chapter expires September 1, 2025 [~~2013~~].

11 SECTION 2. Section 443.003, Government Code, is amended by
12 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

13 (e) The governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker, as a
14 member of the board, may designate a representative to act,
15 including the ability to vote, on behalf of the member during a
16 board meeting.

17 SECTION 3. Section 443.004(b), Government Code, is amended
18 to read as follows:

19 (b) The board shall meet at least twice each year and at
20 other times at the call of the governor and as provided by board
21 rules.

22 SECTION 4. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by
23 adding Section 443.0295 to read as follows:

24 Sec. 443.0295. GOVERNOR'S MANSION RENEWAL TRUST FUND. (a)

1 The Governor's Mansion renewal trust fund is created as a trust fund
2 outside the treasury with the comptroller and shall be administered
3 by the board, as a trustee on behalf of the people of this state, to
4 maintain and preserve the Governor's Mansion. The fund consists of:

5 (1) money transferred to the fund at the direction of
6 the legislature; and

7 (2) money donated to the board for the purposes of
8 preserving and maintaining the Governor's Mansion.

9 (b) Money in the fund may be used only for the purpose of
10 performing major repairs to or preserving the Governor's Mansion,
11 as determined by the board.

12 (c) The interest received from investment of money in the
13 fund shall be credited to the fund.

14 SECTION 5. Chapter 445, Government Code, is amended by
15 adding Sections 445.014 and 445.015 to read as follows:

16 Sec. 445.014. MUSEUM DIRECTOR. The executive director of
17 the State Preservation Board shall employ a museum director to
18 manage and operate the museum.

19 Sec. 445.015. NAMING OF MUSEUM AREAS. The State
20 Preservation Board shall adopt reasonable policies for naming areas
21 within the museum, including rooms and exhibition halls, in honor
22 of donors or other benefactors, if appropriate.

23 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
