 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the continuation and functions of the State
 1-18 Preservation Board.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 443.002, Government Code, is amended to
 1-21 read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 443.002. SUNSET PROVISION. The State Preservation
 1-23 Board is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless
 1-24 continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the board is
 1-25 abolished and this chapter expires September 1, 2025 [2013].

1-26 SECTION 2. Section 443.003, Government Code, is amended by
 1-27 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-28 (e) The governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the
 1-29 house of representatives, as a member of the board, may designate a
 1-30 representative to act, including the ability to vote, on behalf of
 1-31 the member during a board meeting.

1-32 SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 443.004, Government
 1-33 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-34 (b) The board shall meet at least twice each year and at
 1-35 other times at the call of the governor and as provided by board
 1-36 rules.

1-37 SECTION 4. Chapter 445, Government Code, is amended by
 1-38 adding Section 445.014 to read as follows:

1-39 Sec. 445.014. MUSEUM DIRECTOR. The executive director of
 1-40 the State Preservation Board shall employ a museum director to
 1-41 manage and operate the museum.

1-42 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
