A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the continuation and functions of the Texas Commission
- 3 on the Arts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 444.002, Government
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The Texas Commission on the Arts is subject to Chapter
- 8 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided
- 9 by that chapter, the commission is abolished and this chapter
- 10 expires September 1, 2025 [2013].
- 11 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 444.003, Government Code,
- 12 is amended to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 444.003. COMPOSITION; TERMS.
- SECTION 3. Section 444.003, Government Code, is amended by
- 15 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 16 follows:
- 17 (a) The commission is composed of $\underline{\text{nine}}$ [17] members
- 18 appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate.
- 19 The members must represent <u>a diverse cross-section of the</u> [all]
- 20 fields of the arts and be widely known for their professional
- 21 competence and experience in connection with the arts. At least two
- 22 members must be residents of a county with a population of less than
- 23 50,000. Appointments to the commission shall be made without
- 24 regard to the race, color, disability, sex, religion, age, or

- 1 national origin of the appointees.
- 2 (c) Members of the commission serve staggered terms of six
- 3 years.
- 4 SECTION 4. Section 444.024, Government Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a) The commission may award grants in accordance with the
- 8 commission's mission to advance the state economically and
- 9 culturally by investing in the arts in this state.
- 10 (a-1) An applicant for a grant of money from the commission
- 11 shall specify in the grant application a minimum and maximum amount
- 12 of money requested.
- 13 SECTION 5. (a) The six positions on the Texas Commission
- 14 on the Arts that have terms scheduled to expire on August 31, 2013,
- 15 are abolished on that date.
- 16 (b) Two of the six positions on the Texas Commission on the
- 17 Arts with terms scheduled to expire on August 31, 2015, are
- 18 abolished on that date.
- 19 (c) In appointing members to the Texas Commission on the
- 20 Arts for terms scheduled to begin September 1, 2015, the governor
- 21 shall appoint three members to the commission for terms expiring
- 22 August 31, 2021, and one member to the commission for a term
- 23 expiring August 31, 2019.
- 24 (d) In appointing members to the Texas Commission on the
- 25 Arts for terms scheduled to begin September 1, 2017, the governor
- 26 shall appoint three members to the commission for terms expiring
- 27 August 31, 2023, and two members to the commission for terms

- 1 expiring August 31, 2019.
- 2 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 3 last day of the legislative session.
