5	SECTION 1. Subdivision (1), Section 541.201,
6	Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	(1) "Authorized emergency vehicle" means:
8	(A) a fire department or police vehicle;
9	(B) a public or private ambulance operated by a
10	person who has been issued a license by the [Texas] Department of
11	State Health Services;

- Sec. 546.0065. AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY VEHICLES OF THE TEXAS
- 11 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT. The department shall designate
- 12 vehicles of the Texas Division of Emergency Management that may be
- 13 operated as authorized emergency vehicles.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
