The department may not 7 Sec. 522.022. issue a commercial driver's license other than a nonresident 8 license to a person unless the person: 9 10 (1) has a domicile: in this state; or 11 (A) (B) in another state and is a member of the United 12 13 States armed forces, including a member of the National Guard or a reserve or auxiliary unit of any branch of the armed forces, whose 14 15 temporary or permanent duty station is located in this state; 16 (2) has passed knowledge and skills tests for driving a commercial motor vehicle that comply with minimal federal 17 standards established by 49 C.F.R. Part 383, Subparts G and H; and 18 19 (3) has satisfied the requirements imposed by the federal act, federal regulation, or state law. 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 21
