1-13 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-14 AN ACT

1-15 relating to an exception to the domicile requirement for issuance  
1-16 of a commercial driver's license for certain military personnel.

1-17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-18 SECTION 1. Section 522.022, Transportation Code, is amended  
1-19 to read as follows:

1-20 Sec. 522.022. LICENSE REQUIREMENTS. The department may not  
1-21 issue a commercial driver's license other than a nonresident  
1-22 license to a person unless the person:

1-23 (1) has a domicile:

1-24 (A) in this state; or

1-25 (B) in another state and is a member of the United  
1-26 States armed forces, including a member of the National Guard or a  
1-27 reserve or auxiliary unit of any branch of the armed forces, whose  
1-28 temporary or permanent duty station is located in this state;

1-29 (2) has passed knowledge and skills tests for driving  
1-30 a commercial motor vehicle that comply with minimal federal  
1-31 standards established by 49 C.F.R. Part 383, Subparts G and H; and

1-32 (3) has satisfied the requirements imposed by the  
1-33 federal act, federal regulation, or state law.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
