17	Family Code, or Chapter 54 or 54A; or
18	(ii) a master or magistrate under Chapter
19	<u>54</u> .
20	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
21	to an application to obtain or renew a license to carry a concealed
22	handgun submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. Ar
23	application submitted before the effective date of this Act is
