- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 3
- SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 431.131, Government Δ
- Code, is amended to read as follows: 5
- 6 The legislature by concurrent resolution may direct the
- governor to award the Texas Legislative Medal of Honor to a person 7
- 8 nominated by the nominating committee. The committee chairs
- serving on the nominating committee shall jointly prepare a 9
- 10 concurrent resolution directing the governor to award the medal to
- a person nominated. The legislature may direct the medal to be 11
- 12 awarded only during a regular session and may not, during a regular
- session, direct the medal to be awarded to more than: 13
- 14 (1) one person for service in the state or federal
- 15 military forces during the period beginning after 1835 but before
- 1956; and 16

- 17 (2) one person for service in the state or federal
- military forces after 1955 [during a regular session]. 18
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22
- Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 23
