- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 431.131(d), Government Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The legislature by concurrent resolution may direct the
- 7 governor to award the Texas Legislative Medal of Honor to a person
- nominated by the nominating committee. The committee chairs 8
- serving on the nominating committee shall jointly prepare a 9
- concurrent resolution directing the governor to award the medal to 10
- 11 a person nominated. The legislature may direct the medal to be
- 12 awarded only during a regular session and may not, during a regular
- session, direct the medal to be awarded to more than: 13
- 14 (1) one person for service in the state or federal
- military forces during the period beginning after 1835 but before 15
- 16 1956; and

- (2) one person for service in the state or federal 17
- military forces after 1955 [during a regular session]. 18
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
