- 10 training, or education toward the licensing requirements, other
- 11 than examination requirements, for a license issued by the
- 12 department.
- 13 (b) The commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 14 this section.
- SECTION 2. (a) Subsection (a), Section 51.4013,
- 16 Occupations Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an
- 17 application for a license filed with the Texas Department of
- 18 Licensing and Regulation on or after May 1, 2014. An application
- 19 for a license filed with the department before May 1, 2014, is
- 20 governed by the law in effect on the date the application was filed,
- 21 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
