5	SECTION 1. Subsection (b-1), Section 33.02, Penal Code, is

7	(b-1) A person commits an offense if:
8	$\underline{(1)}$ with the intent to defraud or harm another or
9	alter, damage, or delete property, the person knowingly accesses a
10	computer, computer network, or computer system without the
11	effective consent of the owner; or
12	(2) with the intent to obtain a benefit, the person
13	knowingly accesses a computer, computer network, or computer system
14	<pre>in violation of:</pre>
15	(A) a clear and conspicuous prohibition by the
16	owner of the computer, computer network, or computer system; or
17	(B) a contractual agreement to which the person
18	has expressly agreed.
19	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
20	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is

covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the

former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of

this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
