1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to permits for oversize and overweight vehicles in a  
1-20 certain county.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 623.252, Transportation  
1-23 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (b) A permit issued under this subchapter may authorize:

1-25 (1) the transport of cargo only on the following roads  
1-26 in Chambers County:

1-27 (A) Farm-to-Market Road 1405 between its  
1-28 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 2354 and its intersection  
1-29 with Farm-to-Market Road 565;

1-30 (B) the frontage road of State Highway 99 between  
1-31 its crossing with Cedar Bayou and its intersection with Interstate  
1-32 Highway 10 ~~[located in the Cedar Crossing Business Park]~~;

1-33 (C) Farm-to-Market Road 565 from its  
1-34 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 to its intersection with  
1-35 State Highway 99 ~~[east approximately 6,200 linear feet to the~~  
1-36 ~~western edge of the 10-foot pipeline easement recorded at volume~~  
1-37 ~~351, page 760, of the Chambers County deed records]~~; and

1-38 (D) Farm-to-Market Road 2354 from its  
1-39 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 northwest approximately  
1-40 300 linear feet to the termination of the state-maintained portion  
1-41 of the road; and

1-42 (2) the movement of equipment and commodities weighing  
1-43 100,000 pounds or less.

1-44 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
