- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 550.021, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A person commits an offense if the person does not stop
- 8 or does not comply with the requirements of this section. An
- 9 offense under this section:
- 10 (1) involving an accident resulting in:
- 11 (A) death of a person is a felony of the second
- 12 degree; or
- 13 <u>(B)</u> serious bodily injury, as defined by Section
- 14 1.07, Penal Code, to a person is a felony of the third degree; and
- 15 (2) involving an accident resulting in injury to which
- 16 Subdivision (1) does not apply is punishable by:
- 17 (A) imprisonment in the Texas Department of
- 18 Criminal Justice for not more than five years or confinement in the
- 19 county jail for not more than one year;
- 20 (B) a fine not to exceed \$5,000; or
- (C) both the fine and the imprisonment or
- 22 confinement.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 2 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 3 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 4 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 5 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 6 before that date.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
