## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the operation and movement of a vehicle when certain
- 3 traffic-control signals do not display an indication.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 544.007(i) and (j), Transportation
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (i) An operator of a vehicle facing a traffic-control
- 8 signal, other than a freeway entrance ramp control signal or a
- 9 [pedestrian] hybrid beacon, that does not display an indication in
- 10 any of the signal heads shall stop as provided by Section 544.010 as
- 11 if the intersection had a stop sign.
- 12 (j) In this section:
- 13 (1) "Freeway entrance ramp control signal" means a
- 14 traffic-control signal that controls the flow of traffic entering a
- 15 freeway.
- 16 (2) "Hybrid [Pedestrian hybrid] beacon" means a
- 17 controller-activated [pedestrian-controlled] traffic-control
- 18 signal that displays different colored lights successively only
- 19 when activated by a pedestrian, transit vehicle operated by an
- 20 authority under Chapter 451 or 452 or a transit department under
- 21 Chapter 453, emergency vehicle, or other authorized vehicle or
- 22 person.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
