- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 279, Acts of the 56th Legislature,
- 6 Regular Session, 1959, is amended by adding Section 7a to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 7a. The Authority's Board of Directors or a Board
- 9 committee may hold a meeting by telephone conference call, by video
- 10 conference call, or through communications over the Internet, in
- 11 accordance with procedures provided by Subchapter F, Chapter 551,
- 12 Government Code, if holding the meeting in that way is determined to
- 13 be necessary or convenient by the Board president or any three Board
- 14 <u>members.</u>
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 19, Chapter 279, Acts of the 56th
- 16 Legislature, Regular Session, 1959, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 19. Said Authority shall have and may exercise such
- 18 functions, powers, authority, rights and duties as may permit the
- 19 accomplishment of the purposes for which it is created, including
- 20 investigating and planning, acquiring, constructing, maintaining
- 21 and operating of all necessary properties, lands, rights,
- 22 tenements, easements, improvements, reservoirs, dams, canals,
- 23 laterals, plants, works and facilities which it may deem necessary
- 24 or proper for the accomplishment of said purposes, including the

- 1 acquisition within and/or without said Authority of lands,
- 2 rights-of-way, surface water rights, groundwater rights, if
- 3 purchased, as provided by Section 19a, and all other properties,
- 4 tenements, easements and all other rights incident, helpful to, or
- 5 in aid of carrying out the purposes of said Authority as herein
- 6 defined; provided, however, that said Authority shall not engage in
- 7 the generation or distribution of electric power except as provided
- 8 by Section 14b of this Act. The right of eminent domain shall not be
- 9 exercised or extend beyond the boundaries of this District.
- 10 SECTION 3. Chapter 279, Acts of the 56th Legislature,
- 11 Regular Session, 1959, is amended by adding Section 19a to read as
- 12 follows:
- Sec. 19a. The Authority may purchase groundwater rights in
- 14 a county in the Authority's territory only if:
- 15 (1) there is a groundwater conservation district that
- 16 has jurisdiction over water wells located in the county; or
- 17 (2) in the case where a county is not in the
- 18 jurisdiction of a groundwater conservation district, the
- 19 commissioners court of the county approves the purchase of
- 20 groundwater rights by the Authority in the county.
- SECTION 4. Section 25, Chapter 279, Acts of the 56th
- 22 Legislature, Regular Session, 1959, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 25. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as
- 24 authorizing the Authority to acquire $or[\tau]$ regulate [or control in
- 25 any way] underground water or underground water rights by
- 26 condemnation or [purchase or otherwise or to develop,] regulate [or
- 27 control] the use of underground water resources in any manner [+
