BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 279, Acts of the 56th Legislature, 1-25 Regular Session, 1959, is amended by adding Section 7A to read as 1-26 follows:

1**-**27 1**-**28 Sec. 7A. The Authority's Board of Directors or a Board committee may hold a meeting by telephone conference call, by videoconference call, or through communications over the Internet, 1-29 1-30 in accordance with procedures provided by Subchapter F, Chapter 1-31 551, Government Code, if holding the meeting in that way is 1-32 determined to be necessary or convenient by the Board president or 1-33 any three Board members.

SECTION 2. Section 19, Chapter 279, Acts of the 56th 1-34 Legislature, Regular Session, 1959, is amended to read as follows: Sec. 19. Said Authority shall have and may exercise such 1-35

1-36 functions, powers, authority, rights and duties as may permit the accomplishment of the purposes for which it is created, including 1-37 1-38 investigating and planning, acquiring, constructing, maintaining 1-39 operating of all necessary properties, lands, rights, 1-40 and tenements, easements, improvements, reservoirs, dams, canals, laterals, plants, works and facilities which it may deem necessary or proper for the accomplishment of said purposes, including the 1-41 1-42 1-43 acquisition within and/or without said Authority of lands, 1-44 rights-of-way, groundwater and surface water rights and all other properties, tenements, easements and all other rights incident, helpful to, or in aid of carrying out the purposes of said Authority 1-45 1-46 1-47 1-48 as herein defined; provided, however, that said Authority shall not 1-49 engage in the generation or distribution of electric power except as provided by Section 14b of this Act. The right of eminent domain 1-50 shall not be exercised or extend beyond the boundaries of this 1-51 1-52 District.

SECTION 3. Section 25, 1-53 Chapter 279, Acts of the 56th Legislature, Regular Session, 1959, is repealed. SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-54

1-55 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-56 1-57 1-58 1-59 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
