A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the approval requirement for a rental-purchase 3 agreement that includes a loss damage waiver provision. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 92.153, Business & Commerce Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 92.153. RESTRICTIONS ON MERCHANT CONCERNING WAIVER. A 7 merchant may not: 8 sell a loss damage waiver unless: 9 (1)[the department has approved the form of] the 10 (A) 11 contract containing the waiver complies with this chapter; and 12 (B) the consumer agrees to the waiver in writing; 13 or 14 (2) impose or require the purchase of a loss damage waiver as a mandatory charge. 15 SECTION 2. Sections 92.001(2) and (4), 92.158, 92.159, and 16 92.160, Business & Commerce Code, are repealed. 17 18 SECTION 3. (a) An administrative proceeding pending on the effective date of this Act that is related to a complaint filed 19 under Section 92.160, Business & Commerce Code, as that section 20 21 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, is 22 dismissed. 23 (b) An administrative penalty assessed under Section 92.160, Business & Commerce Code, as that section 24 existed

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immediately before the effective date of this Act, and Chapter 51,
Occupations Code, may be collected as provided by Chapter 51,
Occupations Code.

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4 (c) Not later than the 60th day after the effective date of 5 this Act, the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation shall 6 return a prorated portion of the fee paid by a merchant to the 7 department under Section 92.159(2), Business & Commerce Code, as 8 that section existed immediately before the effective date of this 9 Act.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
