A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to electronic voter registration.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Election Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 13.009 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 13.009. ELECTRONIC VOTER REGISTRATION. (a) The
- 7 secretary of state shall implement a program to allow a person to
- 8 complete a voter registration application over the Internet from
- 9 the official website of this state. The websites of the secretary
- 10 of state and the Department of Public Safety must also provide a
- 11 link to the location of the application on the official website of
- 12 this state.
- 13 (b) An applicant for electronic voter registration who has
- 14 <u>an unexpired driver's license or personal identification card</u>
- 15 <u>issued in this state must:</u>
- 16 (1) attest to the truth of the information provided on
- 17 the application by affirmatively accepting the information as true;
- 18 and
- 19 (2) affirmatively consent to the use of the signature
- 20 on the applicant's driver's license or personal identification card
- 21 for voter registration purposes.
- (c) An applicant for electronic voter registration who does
- 23 not have an unexpired driver's license or personal identification
- 24 card issued in this state must:

- 1 (1) attest to the truth of the information provided on
- 2 the application by affirmatively accepting the information as true;
- 3 and
- 4 (2) print a registration application from the website
- 5 the applicant is using to register, sign the application, and mail
- 6 it to the registrar.
- 7 (d) For each application submitted under Subsection (b),
- 8 the program shall require that a digital copy of the applicant's
- 9 signature be obtained from the Department of Public Safety.
- (e) For each application submitted under Subsection (c),
- 11 the program shall provide the applicant with:
- 12 (1) a registration application that the applicant can
- 13 print from the registration website, sign, and mail to the
- 14 registrar as required under Subsection (c)(2); and
- 15 (2) information about how the applicant can obtain a
- 16 driver's license or personal identification card from the
- 17 Department of Public Safety.
- 18 (f) An application submitted under this section is
- 19 considered for all purposes as an application submitted by mail

- 21 (g) The secretary of state shall adopt rules as necessary to

- 25 (h) The rules adopted under Subsection (g) must require

- 1 complete a voter registration application include a description of
- 2 the offense described by Section 13.007 in a conspicuous location
- 3 on the website near the place where the person begins or submits the
- 4 application; and
- 5 (2) the state electronic Internet portal project be
- 6 used to authenticate the identity of a person who submits an
- 7 <u>application electronically under this section.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
