4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Agriculture Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 12.0021 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 12.0021. BEVERAGES ALLOWED TO BE SOLD TO STUDENTS ON
8	PUBLIC SCHOOL CAMPUSES. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b),
9	a public school may not sell or allow to be sold to a student on the
10	school campus any type of beverage other than the following:
11	(1) water without added sweetener;
12	(2) milk with a fat content of one percent or less;
13	(3) fluid milk substitutions permitted by the United
14	States Department of Agriculture under 7 C.F.R. Section 210.10;
15	(4) 100 percent vegetable juice;
16	(5) 100 percent fruit juice;
17	(6) zero-calorie electrolyte replacement or
18	zero-calorie vitamin enhanced water beverages; or
19	(7) an electrolyte replacement beverage other than one
20	described by Subdivision (6), but only if the electrolyte
21	replacement beverage is provided at the discretion of a coach to
22	students engaged in vigorous physical activity lasting at least one
23	hour.
24	(b) Subsection (a) does not apply:

- 1 (1) on a day that school is not in session;
- 2 (2) before the beginning of the breakfast period; or
- 3 (3) after the end of the last instruction period of the
- 4 <u>day</u>.
- 5 (c) The department may adopt rules as necessary to
- 6 <u>administer this section.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2014-2015
- 8 school year.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
