- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 9041, Special District 5
- Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 9041.105 to read as
- follows: 7

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- Sec. 9041.105. POWERS AND DUTIES RELATED TO FILL PROJECTS. 8
- 9 (a) The district has the powers and duties provided by the general
- law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 57, Water Code, 10
- applicable to levee improvement districts created under Section 59, 11
- Article XVI, Texas Constitution. 12
- (b) The district may: 13
- 14 (1) reclaim land in the district; and
- (2) construct works, facilities, and improvements 15
- 16 necessary to accomplish that purpose.
- (c) The district may finance and contract for the 17
- construction of a fill project or for the acquisition of land for a 18
- fill project in the district, including drainage and reclamation. 19
- (d) For the district's exercise of a power of or performance 20
- of a duty of a levee improvement district as provided by Subsection 21
- (c), the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality shall consider 22
- 23 the district to be a levee improvement district.
- 24 SECTION 2. (a) The legal notice of the intention to

- 1 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 2 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 3 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 4 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 5 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 6 Government Code.
- 7 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 8 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 9 Environmental Quality.
- 10 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 11 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 12 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 13 representatives within the required time.
- 14 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 15 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 16 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 17 and accomplished.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
