4	SECTION 1. Chapter 651, Government Code, is amended by
5	adding Section 651.010 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 651.010. ENTREPRENEUR-IN-RESIDENCE. (a) In this
7	section, "state agency" means a board, commission, department,
8	office, or other agency in the executive branch of state government
9	created under the constitution or a statute of this state,
10	including an institution of higher education as defined by Section
11	61.003, Education Code.
12	(b) From available funds, a state agency may hire an
13	entrepreneur-in-residence or contract with an individual, chamber
14	of commerce, or nonprofit entity to:
15	(1) improve outreach by state government to the
16	private sector, including historically underutilized businesses;
17	(2) strengthen coordination and interaction between
18	state government and the private sector;
19	(3) facilitate the understanding and use of
20	technological advances to make state government more transparent
21	and interactive; and
22	(4) implement the best private sector practices to
23	make state government programs simpler, easier to access, more
24	efficient, and more responsive to users.
