- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 651, Government Code, is amended by

- 7 Sec. 651.010. ENTREPRENEUR-IN-RESIDENCE. (a) In this
- 8 section, "state agency" means a board, commission, department,
- 9 office, or other agency in the executive branch of state government
- 10 created under the constitution or a statute of this state,
- 11 including an institution of higher education as defined by Section
- 12 <u>61.003</u>, Education Code.
- 13 (b) From available funds, a state agency may hire an
- 14 entrepreneur-in-residence to:
- 15 (1) improve outreach by state government to the
- 16 private sector;
- 17 (2) strengthen coordination and interaction between
- 18 state government and the private sector;
- 19 (3) facilitate the understanding and use of
- 20 technological advances to make state government more transparent
- 21 and interactive; and
- 22 (4) implement the best private sector practices to
- 23 make state government programs simpler, easier to access, more
- 24 efficient, and more responsive to users.
