## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to methods used by an animal shelter to euthanize a dog or
3	cat.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 821.051, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by amending Subdivisions (3) and (4) and adding Subdivision
7	(5) to read as follows:
8	(3) "Board" means the <u>executive commissioner</u> [ <del>Texas</del>
9	Board of Health].
10	(4) "Department" means the [ <del>Texas</del> ] Department of <u>State</u>
11	Health <u>Services</u> .
12	(5) "Executive commissioner" means the executive
13	commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission.
14	SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 821.052, Health and
15	Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
16	(a) A person may euthanize a dog or cat in the custody of an
17	animal shelter only by administering sodium pentobarbital [ <del>or</del>
18	commercially compressed carbon monoxide].
19	SECTION 3. Section 821.054, Health and Safety Code, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	Sec. 821.054. REQUIREMENTS FOR USE OF COMMERCIALLY
22	COMPRESSED CARBON MONOXIDE. (a) The <u>executive commissioner</u>
23	[ <del>board</del> ] by rule shall establish:
24	(1) standards for a carbon monoxide chamber used to

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1 euthanize an animal to which Section 821.052(b) applies [in the 2 custody of an animal shelter]; and

3 (2) requirements and procedures for administering 4 commercially compressed carbon monoxide to euthanize an animal <u>to</u> 5 <u>which Section 821.052(b) applies</u> [<del>in the custody of an animal</del> 6 <del>shelter</del>].

7 (b) A person administering commercially compressed carbon
8 monoxide to euthanize an animal to which Section 821.052(b) applies
9 [in the custody of an animal shelter]:

10 (1) may use only a carbon monoxide chamber that meets
11 the standards established by <u>department</u> [board] rule; and

12 (2) may administer the commercially compressed carbon
13 monoxide only in accordance with the requirements and procedures
14 established by <u>department</u> [board] rule.

15 SECTION 4. Not later than December 1, 2013, the executive 16 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall 17 adopt rules necessary to conform to Subsection (a), Section 18 821.052, and Section 821.054, Health and Safety Code, as amended by 19 this Act.

20 SECTION 5. A person subject to Subsection (a), Section 21 821.052, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, is not 22 required to comply with that subsection or any rules adopted under 23 that subsection until January 1, 2014.

SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
