## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to breakfast for certain public school students.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 33.901, Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:

If at least 10 6 Sec. 33.901. BREAKFAST PROGRAMS. (a) 7 percent of the students enrolled in one or more schools in a school district or enrolled in an open-enrollment charter school are 8 9 eligible for free or reduced-price breakfasts under the national school breakfast program provided for by the Child Nutrition Act of 10 11 1966 (42 U.S.C. Section 1773), the governing body of the district or the open-enrollment charter school shall participate in the program 12 and make the benefits of the program available to all eligible 13 14 students in the schools or school.

(b) A school district campus or an open-enrollment charter school participating in the national school breakfast program provided by the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. Section 1773) in which 80 percent or more of the students qualify for a free or reduced-price breakfast shall provide a free breakfast to each student during school hours.

21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014 22 school year.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
