- 2 relating to the recording of an informal settlement conference to
- 3 resolve a complaint to the Texas Medical Board against a physician.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (i), Section 164.003, Occupations
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (i) On request by a physician under review, the board shall
- 8 make a recording of the informal settlement conference
- 9 proceeding. The recording is a part of the investigative file and
- 10 may not be released to a third party unless authorized under this
- 11 subtitle. On request of the physician, the board shall release the
- 12 recording to the physician. The board may charge the physician a
- 13 fee to cover the cost of recording the proceeding.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
