 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the recording of an informal settlement conference to  
 1-20 resolve a complaint to the Texas Medical Board against a physician.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subsection (i), Section 164.003, Occupations  
 1-23 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (i) On request by a physician under review, the board shall  
 1-25 make a recording of the informal settlement conference proceeding.  
 1-26 The recording is a part of the investigative file and may not be  
 1-27 released to a third party unless authorized under this subtitle. On  
 1-28 request of the physician, the board shall release the recording to  
 1-29 the physician. The board may charge the physician a fee to cover  
 1-30 the cost of recording the proceeding.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
