- 9 as ordered by a judge exists independently of any requirement to pay
- 10 the fine or court cost as a condition of the defendant's community
- 11 supervision. A defendant remains obligated to pay any unpaid fine
- 12 or court cost after the expiration of the defendant's period of
- 13 community supervision.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
