1-15 AN ACT

1-16 relating to a defendant's obligation to pay a fine or court cost
1-17 after the expiration of a period of community supervision.

1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 11, Article 42.12, Code of Criminal
1-20 Procedure, is amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
1-21 follows:

1-22 (b-1) A defendant's obligation to pay a fine or court cost
1-23 as ordered by a judge exists independently of any requirement to pay
1-24 the fine or court cost as a condition of the defendant's community
1-25 supervision. A defendant remains obligated to pay any unpaid fine
1-26 or court cost after the expiration of the defendant's period of
1-27 community supervision.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
