S.B. No. 398

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to conforming the eligibility under a major events trust  
3 fund of a National Collegiate Athletic Association Division I  
4 Football Bowl Subdivision postseason event with the changes to the  
5 Bowl Championship Series system.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 5A(a)(4), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts  
8 of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14,  
9 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

10 (4) "Event" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate  
11 Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National  
12 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the National Hockey League  
13 All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star Game, a game of  
14 the National Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl Championship  
15 Series or its successor or a National Collegiate Athletic  
16 Association Division I Football Bowl Subdivision postseason  
17 playoff or championship game, a World Cup Soccer game, the World  
18 Games, a national collegiate championship of an amateur sport  
19 sanctioned by the national governing body of the sport that is  
20 recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, an Olympic  
21 activity, including a Junior or Senior activity, training program,  
22 or feeder program sanctioned by the United States Olympic  
23 Committee's Community Olympic Development Program, the Breeders'  
24 Cup World Championships, a Formula One automobile race, the Academy

1 of Country Music Awards, the National Cutting Horse Association  
2 Triple Crown, or a national political convention of the Republican  
3 National Committee or the Democratic National Committee. The term  
4 includes any activities related to or associated with an event.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
9 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
