4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 51, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 51.2525 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.2525. CONFIDENTIALITY OF COMPLAINTS AND
8	INVESTIGATIONS. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, except as
9	provided by Subsection (b) or (c), a complaint against a persor
10	filed with the department or an investigation of a person conducted
11	by the department and all information and material compiled by the
12	department related to the complaint or investigation is:
13	(1) confidential and not subject to disclosure under
14	Chapter 552, Government Code; and
15	(2) not subject to disclosure, discovery, subpoena, or
16	other means of legal compulsion for release to anyone.
17	(b) Information regarding the complaint or the
18	investigation described by Subsection (a) may be disclosed to:
19	(1) the department or a department employee or agent
20	involved in a disciplinary or other administrative proceeding;
21	(2) a party to the disciplinary or other
22	administrative proceeding or the party's designated agent;
23	(3) a licensing or disciplinary board in another
24	jurisdiction;

- 1 (4) a law enforcement agency; or
- 2 (5) a person engaged in bona fide research, if all
- 3 <u>information identifying a specific person has been deleted.</u>
- 4 (c) The filing of formal proceedings against a person by the
- 5 department, the nature of those proceedings, disciplinary
- 6 proceedings of the department, and final disciplinary actions,
- 7 including warnings and reprimands, by the department are not
- 8 confidential and are subject to disclosure in accordance with
- 9 Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 51.2525, Occupations Code, as added by
- 11 this Act, applies only to a complaint filed or an investigation
- 12 commenced on or after the effective date of this Act. A complaint
- 13 filed or an investigation commenced before that date is governed by
- 14 the law in effect on the date the complaint was filed or the
- 15 investigation was commenced, and the former law is continued in
- 16 effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
