- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11.44, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), if [If] an order
- 10 of suspension against a permit or license is pending or unexpired,
- 11 or if the commission has initiated action to cancel or suspend a
- 12 permit or license, no permit or license may be issued for or
- 13 transferred to the same licensed premises.
- 14 <u>(c) The commission may issue an original permit or license</u>
- 15 covering an otherwise permitted or licensed premises under
- 16 conditions described by Subsection (a) if:
- 17 (1) the holder of the permit or license that is subject
- 18 to the pending or unexpired suspension order or against which the
- 19 cancellation or suspension action has been initiated has been
- 20 evicted from the premises under a final, nonappealable court
- 21 judgment; and
- 22 (2) all other conditions for the issuance of the new
- 23 permit or license covering the premises are met by the applicant.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
