A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to authorization by the Texas Higher Education
- 3 Coordinating Board for certain public junior colleges to offer
- 4 baccalaureate degree programs.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 130.0012, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (b) and (g) and adding Subsection (g-1) to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (b) The coordinating board shall authorize baccalaureate
- 10 degree programs at:
- 11 (1) each public junior college that previously
- 12 participated in a pilot project to offer baccalaureate degree
- 13 programs; and
- 14 (2) one or more public junior colleges that offer a
- 15 degree program in the field of nursing if the public junior college
- 16 <u>is located in a county with a population greater than 3.3 million at</u>
- 17 the time the degree is initially offered.
- 18 (g) Except as provided by Subsection (g-1), in $[\frac{1}{2}]$ its
- 19 recommendations to the legislature relating to state funding for
- 20 public junior colleges, the coordinating board shall recommend that
- 21 a public junior college receive substantially the same state
- 22 support for junior-level and senior-level courses offered under
- 23 this section as that provided to a general academic teaching
- 24 institution for substantially similar courses. In determining the

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- 1 contact hours attributable to students enrolled in a junior-level
- 2 or senior-level course offered under this section used to determine
- 3 a public junior college's proportionate share of state
- 4 appropriations under Section 130.003, the coordinating board shall
- 5 weigh those contact hours as necessary to provide the junior
- 6 college the appropriate level of state support to the extent state
- 7 funds for those courses are included in the appropriations. This
- 8 subsection does not prohibit the legislature from directly
- 9 appropriating state funds to support junior-level and senior-level
- 10 courses offered under this section.
- 11 (g-1) A degree program created under Subsection (b)(2) may
- 12 be funded solely by a public junior college's proportionate share
- 13 of state appropriations under Section 130.003, local funds, and
- 14 private sources. This subsection does not require the legislature
- 15 to appropriate state funds to support a degree program created
- 16 <u>under Subsection (b)(2).</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
