## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to public access to personal financial statements filed by
- 3 candidates for and holders of state office and state chairs of
- 4 political parties.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 572.032, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (a), (a-1), and (c) and adding Subsection
- 8 (a-2) to read as follows:
- 9 (a) Financial statements filed under this subchapter are
- 10 public records. The commission shall:
- 11 (1) maintain the statements in separate alphabetical
- 12 files and in a manner that is accessible to the public during
- 13 regular office hours; and
- 14 (2) not later than the 10th business day after the date
- 15 a statement is filed, post the statement on the commission's
- 16 Internet website.
- 17 (a-1) The commission shall remove the home address of a
- 18 judge or justice from a financial statement filed under this
- 19 subchapter before:
- 20 (1) permitting a member of the public to view the
- 21 statement; [<del>or</del>]
- 22 (2) providing a copy of the statement to a member of
- 23 the public; or
- 24 (3) posting the statement on the commission's Internet

- 1 website.
- 2 (a-2) In posting financial statements on the commission's
- 3 Internet website, the commission shall to the extent practicable
- 4 arrange the statements in a manner that:
- 5 (1) groups together the statements filed by
- 6 individuals holding or seeking the same type of office; and
- 7 (2) groups together all statements filed by an
- 8 individual that appear on the website.
- 9 (c) After the second anniversary of the date the individual
- 10 ceases to be a state officer, the commission may and on notification
- 11 from the former state officer shall:
- 12 (1) destroy each financial statement filed by the
- 13 state officer; and
- 14 (2) remove each financial statement filed by the state
- officer from the commission's Internet website.
- SECTION 2. Section 572.032(b), Government Code, is
- 17 repealed.
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 572.032, Government Code, as amended by
- 19 this Act, applies only to a financial statement filed under
- 20 Subchapter B, Chapter 572, Government Code, that is due on or after
- 21 September 1, 2013.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
