1-19 relating to service of citation on a financial institution.
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 17.028, Civil Practice and Remedies
 1-22 Code, is amended by amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding
 1-23 Subsection (f) to read as follows:
 1-24 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), ~~[in an action~~
 1-25 ~~against a financial institution,~~ citation may be served on a
 1-26 financial institution by:
 1-27 (1) serving the registered agent of the financial
 1-28 institution; or
 1-29 (2) if the financial institution does not have a
 1-30 registered agent, serving the president or a branch manager at any
 1-31 office located in this state.
 1-32 (c) Citation ~~[In an action against a credit union organized~~
 1-33 ~~under the laws of this state, another state, or federal law,~~
 1-34 ~~citation]~~ may be served on a credit union by:
 1-35 (1) serving the registered agent of the credit union;
 1-36 or
 1-37 (2) if the credit union does not have a registered
 1-38 agent, serving the president or vice president.
 1-39 (f) Service on and delivery to a financial institution of
 1-40 claims against a customer of the financial institution are governed
 1-41 by Section 59.008, Finance Code.
 1-42 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
