4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 661, Government Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 661.920 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 661.920. LEAVE FOR REEMPLOYED VETERANS. A state employee who is reemployed by a state agency after military service 8 as provided by Section 431.006 or Chapter 613 shall be granted leave 9 10 to tend to matters relating to the employee's military service or reintegration into civilian life, including obtaining medical or 11 12 mental health care and receiving employee assistance counseling. 13 Leave under this section may not exceed 15 days without a deduction in salary or loss of vacation time, sick leave, earned overtime 14 15 credit, or state compensatory time. Leave under this section may not be used after the first anniversary of the date the employee is 16 17 reemployed by the state agency. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 18
