- this section, "reserve law enforcement officer" has the meaning 8
- assigned by Section 1701.001, Occupations Code. 9
- 10 (b) A state employee who is a reserve law enforcement
- officer is entitled to a leave of absence without a deduction in 11
- salary to attend training required under Section 1701.351, 12
- 13 Occupations Code. Leave without deduction in salary under this
- section may not exceed five working days every fiscal biennium. 14
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18
- Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 19
