A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the audit of certain river authorities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. AUDIT. Chapter 321, Government Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Section 321.024 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 321.024. CERTAIN RIVER AUTHORITIES SUBJECT TO AUDIT.
- 7 (a) The financial transactions of a river authority listed in
- 8 Subsection (b) are subject to audit under this chapter.
- 9 (b) This section applies only to the:
- 10 (1) Brazos River Authority; and
- 11 (2) Lower Colorado River Authority.
- 12 (c) A river authority shall pay the cost incurred by the
- 13 state auditor in conducting an audit of the authority under this
- 14 section. The state auditor shall determine the cost, and the
- 15 authority shall pay the amount promptly on receipt of a statement
- 16 from the state auditor detailing the cost.
- 17 SECTION 2. BRAZOS RIVER AUTHORITY. Chapter 8502, Special
- 18 District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 8502.0051 to
- 19 read as follows:
- Sec. 8502.0051. AUDIT. The authority is subject to the
- 21 <u>audit provisions of Section 321.024, Government Code.</u>
- 22 SECTION 3. LOWER COLORADO RIVER AUTHORITY. Section
- 23 8503.015, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as
- 24 follows:

- 1 Sec. 8503.015. AUDIT. The authority is subject to the audit
- 2 provisions of:
- 3 (1) Subchapter G, Chapter 49, Water Code; and
- 4 (2) Section 321.024, Government Code.
- 5 SECTION 4. TRANSITION. (a) Subject to approval by the
- 6 Legislative Audit Committee for inclusion in the audit plan under
- 7 Subsection (c), Section 321.013, Government Code, the state auditor
- 8 shall audit the Brazos River Authority and the Lower Colorado River
- 9 Authority under Section 321.024, Government Code, as added by this
- 10 Act.
- 11 (b) A river authority audited under this section shall
- 12 cooperate and provide assistance and access to all necessary
- 13 records, confidential or nonconfidential, to the state auditor in
- 14 conducting the audit under this section.
- 15 (c) Not later than December 31, 2015, the state auditor
- 16 shall prepare a written report for an audit conducted under this
- 17 section and file the report in accordance with Section 321.014,
- 18 Government Code.
- 19 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 20 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 21 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 22 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 23 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
