(a) 12 Code, as amended by this Act, and subject to approval by the Legislative Audit Committee for inclusion in the audit plan under 13 14 Section 321.013(c), Government Code, the state auditor shall conduct comprehensive financially related audits, including audits 15 of the operations and performance, of the Lower Colorado River 16 Authority. 17 18 (b) A river authority audited under this section shall cooperate and provide assistance and access to all necessary 19 records, confidential or nonconfidential, to the state auditor in 20 21 conducting the audit under this section. 22 (c) Not later than January 1, 2015, the state auditor shall 23 prepare a written report for an audit conducted under this section and file the report in accordance with Section 321.014, Government 24

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1 Code.

2 (d) A river authority audited under this section shall
3 reimburse the state auditor for the cost of performing the audit.
4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
