A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to the confidentiality of certain autopsy records.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 11, Article 49.25, Code of Criminal
- 5 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 11. RECORDS. (a) The medical examiner shall keep
- 7 full and complete records properly indexed, giving the name if
- 8 known of every person whose death is investigated, the place where
- 9 the body was found, the date, the cause and manner of death, and
- 10 shall issue a death certificate. The full report and detailed
- 11 findings of the autopsy, if any, shall be a part of the record.
- 12 Copies of all records shall promptly be delivered to the proper
- 13 district, county, or criminal district attorney in any case where
- 14 further investigation is advisable. The records may not be
- 15 withheld, subject to a discretionary exception under [are subject
- 16 to required public disclosure in accordance with] Chapter 552,
- 17 Government Code, except that a photograph or x-ray of a body taken
- 18 during an autopsy is excepted from required public disclosure in
- 19 accordance with Chapter 552, Government Code, but is subject to
- 20 disclosure:
- 21 (1) under a subpoena or authority of other law; or
- 22 (2) if the photograph or x-ray is of the body of a
- 23 person who died while in the custody of law enforcement.
- 24 (b) Under the exception to public disclosure provided by

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- 1 Subsection (a), a governmental body as defined by Section 552.003,
- 2 Government Code, may withhold a photograph or x-ray described by
- 3 Subsection (a) without requesting a decision from the attorney
- 4 general under Subchapter G, Chapter 552, Government Code. This
- 5 subsection does not affect the required disclosure of a photograph
- 6 or x-ray under Subsection (a)(1) or (2).
- 7 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 8 a request for information that is received by a governmental body or
- 9 an officer for public information on or after the effective date of
- 10 this Act. A request for information that was received before the
- 11 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 12 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
- 13 effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
