7	Sec. 201.6035. AUTHORIZATION TO PARTICIPATE IN CERTAIN	
8	FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS. (a) The department may assume	
9	responsibilities of the United States Department of Transportation	
10	with respect to duties under the National Environmental Policy Act	
11	of 1969 (42 U.S.C. Section 4321 et seq.) and with respect to duties	
12	under other federal environmental laws. The department may:	
13	(1) assume responsibilities under 23 U.S.C. Sections	
14	326 and 327; and	
15	(2) enter into one or more agreements, including	
16	memoranda of understanding, with the United States secretary of	
17	transportation related to:	
18	(A) designating categorical exclusions from	
19	federally required environmental assessments or impact statements	
20	for highway projects as provided by 23 U.S.C. Section 326; or	
21	(B) the federal surface transportation project	
22	delivery program for the delivery of transportation projects,	
23	including highway, railroad, public transportation, and multimodal	
24	projects, as provided by 23 U.S.C. Section 327.	

- 1 (b) The commission may adopt rules to implement this section
- 2 and may adopt relevant federal environmental standards as the
- 3 standards for this state for a program described by Subsection (a).
- 4 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), sovereign
- 5 immunity to suit in federal court and from liability is waived and
- 6 abolished with regard to the compliance, discharge, or enforcement
- 7 of a responsibility assumed by the department under this section.
- 8 (d) Subsection (c) does not create liability for the
- 9 department that exceeds the liability created under 23 U.S.C.
- 10 Section 326(c)(3) or 327(d).
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
