Section 552.002, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: 13 14 (b-1) A pharmacy technician board member must, at the time of appointment: 15 16 (1) be a resident of this state; (2) have been registered as a pharmacy technician for 17 the five years preceding appointment; 18 (3) be in good standing to act as a pharmacy technician 19 in this state; and 20 21 (4) be acting as a pharmacy technician in this state. 22 SECTION 3. Section 552.005(a), Occupations Code, is amended 23 to read as follows: 24 (a) Members of the board are appointed for staggered

six-year terms, with either [. The terms of] three or four members' 1 terms, as applicable, expiring [members expire] every other year at 2 midnight on the last day of the state fiscal year in the last year of 3 the member's term. 4 SECTION 4. Section 552.010(a), Occupations Code, is amended 5 6 to read as follows: The board shall meet at least[+ 7 (a) 8 [<del>(1)</del>] once every four months to transact board 9 business[; and 10 [(2) twice each year for the examination of applicants]. 11 SECTION 5. As soon as practicable after the effective date 12 of this Act, the governor shall appoint a pharmacy technician and a 13 14 pharmacist to the Texas State Board of Pharmacy as required by this 15 Act. In appointing the members, the governor shall appoint: 16 (1)a pharmacy technician to a term expiring August 17 31, 2019; and (2) a pharmacist to a term expiring August 31, 2017. 18 19 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
